To **strengthen Jewish identity**, nurturing a meaningful Jewish life with an eye on progress, and consistent with today's world.


To **create bridges between communities** by bringing together people of different cultures and create dialogue.





This program consists of a class taking place every other Sunday from September to June for children from ages 3 to 11. Our goal is to provide the most positive and productive Hebrew School experience for Jewish children, regardless of prior knowledge and background, affiliations, or level of observance. BAT MITZVAH CLUB




